

Keable named 'housing champion' by R.I. Housing

PROVIDENCE - State Rep. Cale Keable, a Democrat representing Glocester and Burrillville, has been named a Housing Champion by Rhode Island Housing as part of its annual Partners in Housing Awards.

The awards recognize individuals who have demonstrated ongoing, committed leadership in addressing the housing needs of all Rhode Islanders, according to a press release last week. The agency says it honored Keable, who has served in the House of Representatives since 2011, for being a strong supporter of housing development.

Keable, chairman of the House Judiciary Committee, has promoted numerous initiatives to improve the state's business and job climate, including his 2012 cosponsorship of a law that requires an assessment of all regulations impacting small businesses, the press release reads.
